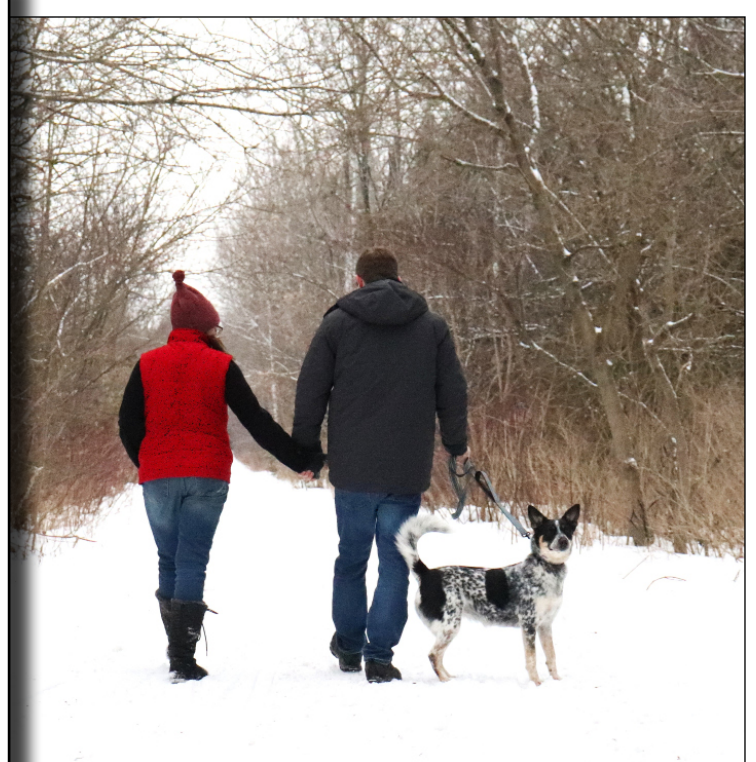

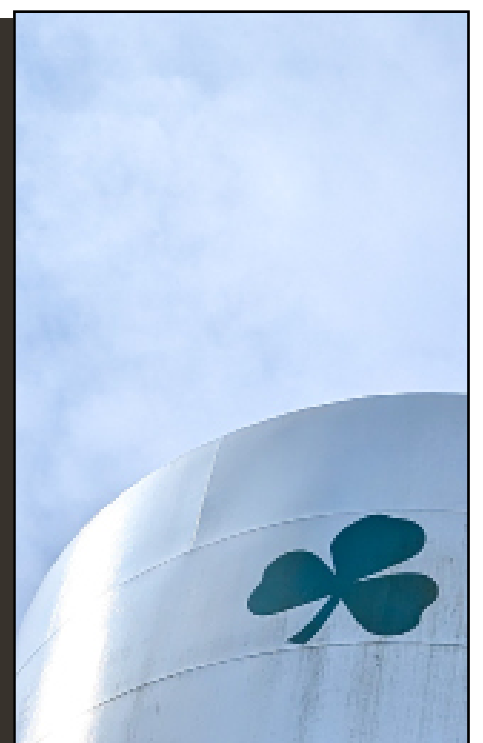
Erin receives \$29M wastewater grant
