

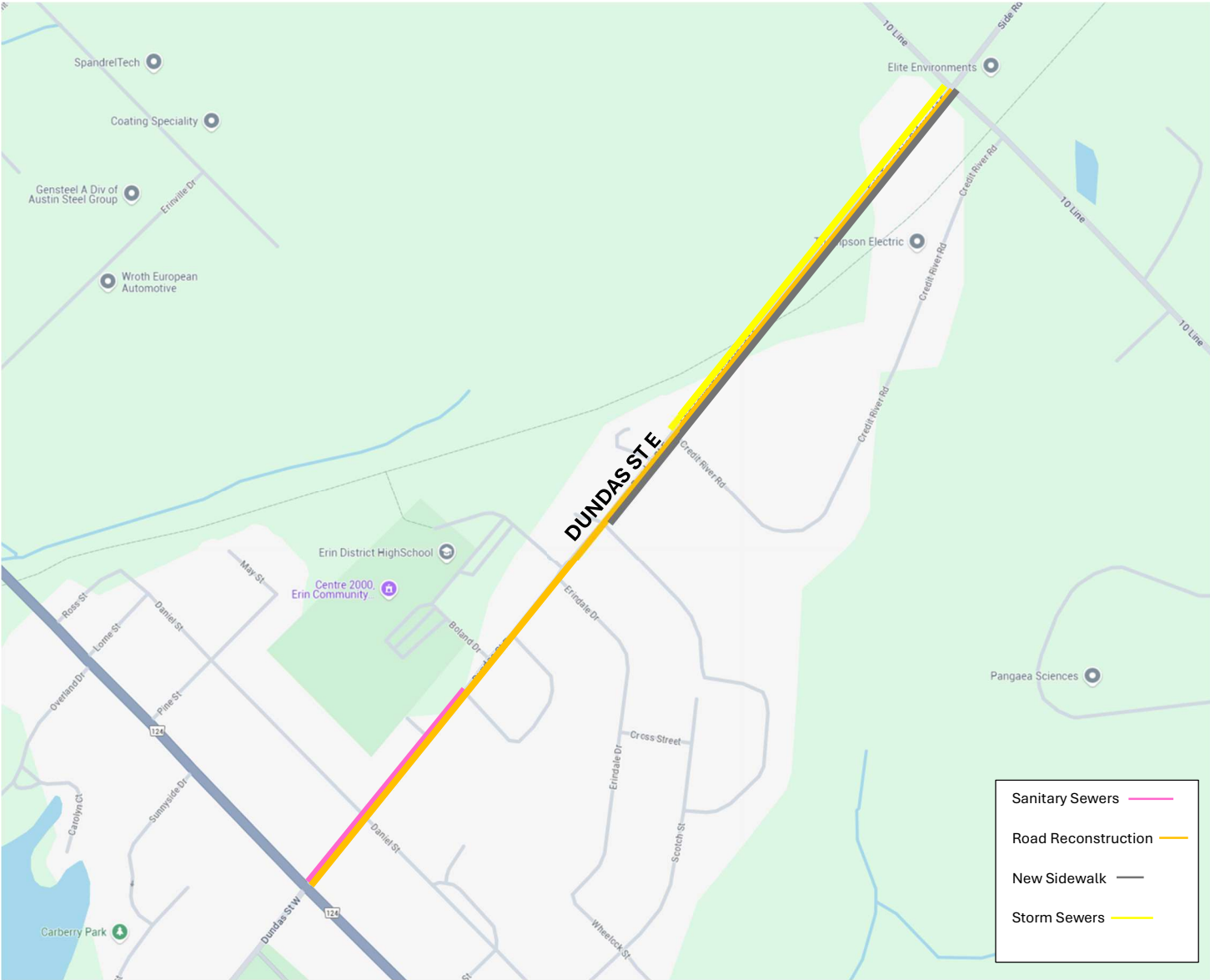
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2025 WORKS

KAPP Infrastructure plans to resume work on March 31, 2025. This date is subject to change based on the weather conditions.

The construction works in 2025 is as follows:

- Sanitary Sewers from Main St to Tomwell Crescent West and Sutton Road to Tenth Line along Dundas St E
- Storm Sewers from Credit River to 10 Line along Dundas St E
- All water and sanitary services (up to property line)
- Full roadway reconstruction – new curb and gutter, sidewalk and asphalt (Dundas St E from Main St to 10 Line)



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TOWN OF ERIN DUNDAS ST E

Infrastructure works will resume along Dundas St E / Sideroad 15 starting April 2025 requiring multiple closures between Daniel St to Tenth Line as the work progresses. Access to local homes, businesses, school bus and emergency services will be always maintained.

Road Closure Duration: **March 31 2025 to Fall 2025**

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

SECTION A – ROAD CLOSURE – LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY - DUNDAS ST E / SIDEROAD 15 BETWEEN CREDIT RIVER RD – TENTH LINE

- Traffic will be required to follow detour routes which will be clearly marked with traffic signs along the approach roads in the work areas. Construction equipment will not travel on Tenth Line due to load restrictions. **Local traffic for homes and businesses will always be allowed.**



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SECTION B – ROAD CLOSURE – LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY - DUNDAS ST E / SIDEROAD 15 BETWEEN TOMWELL WEST CRESCENT AND DANIEL ST

- Traffic will be required to follow detour routes which will be clearly marked with traffic signs along the approach roads in the work areas. **Local traffic for homes and businesses will always be allowed.**
- Tomwell Crescent W will be closed. Vehicular access will be from Tomwell East Crescent.



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SECTION C – ROAD CLOSURE – LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY - DUNDAS ST E / SIDEROAD 15 BETWEEN DANIEL ST AND MAIN ST

- Traffic will be required to follow detour routes which will be clearly marked with traffic signs along the approach roads in the work areas. **Local traffic for homes and businesses will always be allowed.**

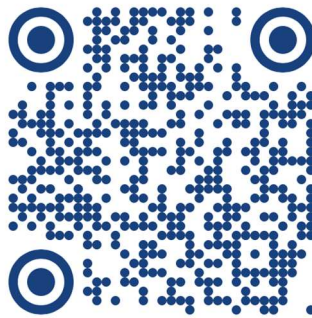

	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, Monday to Friday. Work after hours or on weekends may be required during construction.
	Traffic Management: Road users should expect increased traffic along Dundas St E / Sideroad 15, Main St and Wellington Road 52. Access to local homes and businesses as well as emergency services will be maintained at all times. During working hours, Traffic Control Personnel (TCP) will be in place to ensure the safety of the vehicular and pedestrian traffic.
	Detours: Road restrictions will be in place prior to the road or lane closures. Details on the closures and detours can be found on the Town website and Instagram Page.
	Safety: SAFETY IS A PROIRITY. The work areas will be protected, and warning signs will be posted. <ul style="list-style-type: none">- No trespassing in the Work Area – Authorized Personnel ONLY- All visitors must report to the Site Office (12 Dundas St E)- Children must not enter or play on the job site

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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When will the next PIC be held?

The next PIC will be held prior to the roadway reconstruction between Tomwell Crescent and Credit River Drive.

Will I have access to my property?

Yes, local traffic, emergency vehicles and any clients for the local businesses will always have access.

Will there be any water or utility disruptions?

No, we do not anticipate any utility disruption currently. There is a potential for water disruptions when the new watermain from Erinlea Crescent to Tenth Line is being connected. Homeowners affected by this connection will be provided with a notice at a minimum of 48 hours prior to any disruptions.

Will there be any tree removals? If so, what replanting is being done?

No, we do not anticipate any tree removals currently. If this changes, the homeowners will be made aware and will have ample time to express their thoughts and concerns regarding any replanting.

Will there be any interruptions to mail delivery (Canada Post, Purolator, UPS, etc.)?

No, mail delivery vehicles will be treated as emergency vehicles and will always have access.

Will there be any interruptions to garbage collection?

No, garbage trucks will be treated as emergency vehicles and will always have access.
