For those who prefer to engage in person, the Town will be hosting three community open houses, two in-person and one virtual.



## Town of Erin offering exciting new summer camp lineup

Summer is just around the corner and Erin's recreation and culture team is gearing up for an action-packed season of fun and adventure.

The Town of Erin is launching new specialty summer camp programs this year, encompassing a wide variety of activities and themes.

The Town is introducing an assortment of camp options this year, with programs scheduled for both Erin and Hillsburgh aimed at helping campers discover new sports, find hidden talents, and embrace their creativity. There will also be an Arts and Crafts Camp, Hockey Activity Camp, Multi Sport Camp and Performing Arts Camp.

A Tennis Camp will run in partnership with the Erin Tennis Club from July 28 to Aug. 1, where participants will complete tennis drills and play matches while building core skills of the game. Erin Camp is for children ages 4 to 12, running from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on weekdays. Extended care is available from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. for an additional fee.
